1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS:** To receive disclosures of personal and prejudicial interests from Councillors on matters to be considered at the meeting.

A personal interest is prejudicial if a member of the public with knowledge of the relevant facts would reasonably regard it as so significant that it is likely to prejudice your judgment of the public interest and it relates to a financial or regulatory matter.

- 4 **COMMUNITY FACILITIES: WREXHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL BUDGET REDUCTIONS AND THE ROLE OF COMMUNITY COUNCILS AND COMMUNITY GROUPS:** In accordance with the decision of the Special meeting of the Council held on 24 September 2013 held with Mr Lawrence Isted:

1. to review the Community Council's 2014/15 preliminary budget requirements and to consider the precept implications for the various funding and operational proposals from 2014/15 onwards in respect of ongoing provision for the following Community facilities in the Acton Community:-

- i. **Community Centres** – Borrass Park and Little Acton
- ii. **Play Areas** – Ffordd Garmonydd, Acton Park Senior, Acton Park Junior and Aran Road
- iii. **Public Conveniences** – none
- iv. **Bowling Greens** – Cunliffe Bowling Club
- v. **School Crossing Patrols** - Borrass Park Road, Box Lane and Dean Road

- vi. **Street Lighting** – will be discussed further by members of Wrexham County Borough Council prior to communicating proposals to Community Council's to resolve anomalies in respect of charges for street lighting.

A copy of the approved 2013/14 Estimates of Income and Expenditure is attached. Members are also requested to bring their copy of the Agenda papers and letter from Mr Isted that were circulated for the Special meeting of the Council held on 11 September 2013.
